In the Methods section, under the subtitles "Cell lines and tissue samples for cDNA arrays" and "cDNA probe preparation" we failed to quote the original description of how the cDNA library was generated, published in the Journal Archives of Medical Research as quoted below [2]. Since this initial analysis, further data mining has been performed, and the obtained results answer very different biological questions [1].
